She is in the process of establishing and managing the initiative in this county as her primary focus will be to serve the Africa American and Latinx communities to reduce the recidivism rate. This initiative will also support existing businesses, bring in new businesses, create jobs, and work cohesively with local governments and politicians.

Angelica Robinson, Los Angeles, CA native, is a dynamic Actress, Entertainment Executive and Founding Producer of [Tell Me A Story Productions](#), specializing in multicultural edutainment. She received her MFA in Film and Television Producing from Chapman University; and her BFA in Theatre Arts, Concentration in Acting with a dual major in Film and Television Production from Howard University. Ms. Robinson is a member of the Producer Guild of America, a judge for the 48th Annual Daytime Emmy Awards (with two Television projects of her own under consideration), was recently accepted into the Harvard Business Analytics program for the 2021 cohort, and is currently running for local office in Los Angeles. Angelica has also agreed to be a co-host on [Dr. Surajit Khanna's ReturningYouth Radio / Streaming Video Show](#) broadcasted to over 30 million homes in the NYC tristate area every Friday from 3-4PM on WPAT 930AM and on video on *all* the Facebook, Twitter, and YouTube links listed below. Dr. Surajit Khanna's Post Incarceration Juvenile Justice Reformation Act Initiative provides young adults with a pathway to be reintegrated into society to pursue a new and productive life after being released from incarceration. They will lead a rewarding life as they remain off the streets and free from a life of crime. They will learn life skills, receive job training, gain employment, and pursue long-term education. We have introduced this initiative in New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Montana, Maine, and now California. In addition, we are actively and strategically rolling out the initiative to all other states nationwide. It is being implemented through partnerships with community-based organizations, DA's offices, law enforcement, and the court systems. The initiative's planned expansion and rollout is to ALL 50 US States and 3,142 Counties. The first model program has been established in Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania.
