Dr. Surajit Khanna's ReturningYouth Initiative - **Robert Tanko** Appointed as County Manager of Harris County in the State of Texas



On April 16, 2021, the office of Dr. Surajit Khanna's Post Incarceration Juvenile Justice Reformation Act Initiative, also known as Dr. Surajit Khanna's [ReturningYouth Initiative](#), announced that **Robert Tanko** is appointed as County Manager for Harris County in Texas.

Robert is in the process of establishing and managing Dr. Khanna's initiative in this county as his primary focus will be to serve the Africa American and Latinx communities to reduce the recidivism rate. This initiative will also support existing businesses, bring in new businesses, create jobs, and work cohesively with local governments and politicians.

Mr. Robert Tanko is a seasoned businessman and entrepreneur, and has a Bachelor of Science degree in Business with a Major in Marketing. He was a partner and President of Source Plus Inc. for 20 years where he focused on health and fitness products, and had several successful infomercial products selling over 5 million units worldwide. Then in 2018 after his daughter was diagnosed with cancer, he began to focus on unique medical treatments and the benefits of CBD, while working with key research doctors at UC Irvine. Later in 2020 he became President of the Board for Silver State Health Services Group; a non-profit Federally Qualified health facility offering services to those who can't afford insurance and are in need. He has worked closely with Dr. Khanna on several projects over the past 10 years and looks forward to bringing Dr. Khanna's initiative forward in the state of Texas. He believes that helping people (especially young adults) to have a happy and successful life to be a noble and rewarding profession.

Dr. Surajit Khanna's Post Incarceration Juvenile Justice Reformation Act Initiative provides young adults with a pathway to be reintegrated into society to pursue a new and productive life after being released from incarceration. They will lead a rewarding life remaining off the streets and free from a life of crime. They will learn life skills, receive job training, gain employment, and pursue long-term education. We have introduced this initiative in Illinois, New York, Montana, New Jersey, Maine, California, Pennsylvania, Idaho, and now Texas. In addition, we are actively and strategically rolling out the initiative to all other states nationwide. It is being implemented through partnerships with community-based organizations, DA's offices, law enforcement, and the court systems. The initiative's planned expansion and rollout is to all 50 states and 3,142 counties. The first model program has been established in Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania.
