Dr. Surajit Khanna's ReturningYouth Initiative - **Kevin Alan Skulczyck** Appointed as County Manager of New London County in the State of Connecticut.



On April 19, 2021, the office of Dr. Surajit Khanna's Post Incarceration Juvenile Justice Reformation Act Initiative, also known as Dr. Surajit Khanna's [ReturningYouth Initiative](#), announced that **Kevin Alan Skulczyck** is appointed as County Manager for New London County in Connecticut. Kevin is in the process of establishing and managing Dr. Khanna's initiative in this county as his primary focus will be to serve the Africa American and Latinx communities to reduce the recidivism rate. This initiative will also support existing businesses, bring in new businesses, create jobs, and work cohesively with local governments and politicians.

Kevin Alan Skulczyck is the host of [The Kevin Alan Show Podcast](#). Born and raised in the small town in CT, and later moved to Griswold, CT, where he resides. Kevin has 2 children: Jacob, 24 and Taylor, 21. Kevin began his career in the Connecticut Department of Corrections when he was 21 years old and served 21 years as a Correctional Officer and retired in 2012. In 2013 Kevin was elected as First Selectman of Griswold, and served two terms. In 2016 he was elected to the 45th House of Representatives and served one term. During this time Kevin was also co-owner of a local bar called Pub 45. Taking a break from politics, Kevin lived off the grid as a managerial partner growing 40 acres of industrial hemp. After being interviewed about his farm, he decided to start a podcast. Kevin is excited to be a part of Dr. Surajit Khanna's Returning Youth Initiative. He has a strong desire for social justice and committed to continuing to help post incarcerated young adults by inviting them to this program. He believes he can add value to his county and be a torch bearer to integrate post incarcerated young adults to the community.

Dr. Surajit Khanna's ReturningYouth Initiative provides young adults with a pathway to be reintegrated into society to pursue a productive life after being released from incarceration. They will lead a rewarding life remaining off the streets and free from a life of crime. They will learn life skills, receive job training, gain employment, and pursue long-term education. Currently we have implemented this initiative in New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Illinois, California, Maine, Montana, Idaho, Texas, and now **Connecticut**. It is being implemented through partnerships with community-based organizations, DA's offices, law enforcement, and the court systems. The initiative's planned expansion and rollout is to all 50 States and 3,142 Counties. The first model program has been established in Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania.
